The Centre for the Arts, in partnership with the Cambridge YWCA, was privileged to host this exceptional exhibition conceived and organized by artist Cheryl-Ann Webster.

Cheryl-Ann created over 50 clay sculptures from plaster casts of the torsos of women age 19 to 91 from all backgrounds. After interviewing each woman, she painted the cast torso to reflect their personal experiences, perspectives and stories. The exhibit, showcased in the arts centre multipurpose room, was accompanied by related talks and programs examining women's issues including body image.

Visitors to the exhibition were greatly impacted by the experience. The artistic achievement was impressive, and the resilience, strength and stories of the beautiful women it honoured was profoundly moving.
